### OTHER UPDATES!

- Murphy, Dash, and Bob (all pets on our Animal Therapy Team) were invited to Hard Rock Casino to spend time with their staff.
- Absecon Veterinary Hospital is now qualified to evaluate therapy animal candidates through Pet Partners and AAAIP (Association of Animal-Assisted Intervention Professionals). We are now able to provide resources and guidance to those interested in getting their pet evaluated.
- The January Future Vet Workshop had a great turnout! 30 kids spent time learning from Dr. Eli Parker and playing with Dash, Blitzen, Judy Bootie (Guinea Pig), and Loofah Louise.


