



LILLIES ARE TOXIC TO CATS

WHY

Just one lily leaf, if eaten, can kill your cat, but any part of the plant is dangerous, including the pollen and flower. Simply brushing by the plant, then grooming the pollen off his coat, can prove lethal to a cat.

SYMPTOMS OF INJESTION

The first symptoms likely to occur after your cat has ingested lily are:

- Depression
- Lack of appetite
- Sometimes vomiting

If untreated, he will quickly go downhill, becoming dehydrated and suffering from diarrhea, breathing difficulties, and bad breath. If you think your cat has ingested any part of a lily, take him to your vet as soon as possible.

Acute renal failure is the likely eventual result - if he doesn't receive medical treatment within hours, he may die.
